Locally-owned Locavino will serve as an anchor for the thriving Downtown Silver Spring business and residential community. Taking over the space that formerly housed neighborhood icon Adegá Wine Cellars, Locavino is owned by locals Jarrod Jabre and Justin Wallace, who are continuing a tradition of a neighborhood gathering spot, with a menu focused on chef-driven, locally-sourced fare, and an international-caliber wine and beer list. Additionally, Locavino's world-inspired, but locally-focused beverage list will be available for retail.

Menu:

Jabre and Wallace are crafting an all-day menu comprised of family-recipe appetizers, a signature locally-focused cheese board, and an array of family-friendly sandwiches and wraps. They'll also serve generous salads, a variety of cooked-to-order, ethically-sourced burgers, and crispy flatbreads. House-made stews, soups, signature pastas, and rotating desserts will also be on offer.

Bar/wines

Locavino will feature a value-driven 200+ item wine list featuring known favorites and obscure new varietals from around the world. Of particular focus will be wines Maryland's own booming wine industry, as well as wines sourced from lesser-known regions from around the United States. Their curated beer list will focus on beer sourced from Maryland and its neighboring states, while including international highlights. Jabre and Wallace believe that every wine and beer they sell should have a story, so expect a list dominated by family-owned, quality-driven family producers, with products that express their origin and values.

While managing Adegá Wine Cellars, their efforts were recognized with Silver Spring's only Wine Spectator Award of Excellence.
